Call for Papers

Paper proposals are solicited on any topic related to music theory. Paper presentations should be approximately twenty minutes in length followed by a ten minute question session. Submissions should include the following:

- An anonymous proposal two to three pages in length with no more than four additional pages of supporting examples
- An anonymous abstract of 200-300 words, suitable for publication
- A cover letter providing the title of the proposal, the author's name and institutional affiliation, address, phone number, e-mail address, and a list of any equipment (i.e. stereo, overhead projector) needed for the presentation

The program committee will accept electronic submissions only.

- Electronic submissions must be in Word or PDF formats.
- All submissions must be received by 11:59 PM on December 1, 2009. Please send files as attachments to Crystal Peebles at cap05h@fsu.edu.
